Bible Study questions - same questions used every week.

Summarize the previous sections up to our current passage.

What do you notice in this passage or from the Sunday message?

What are the key points that are made in this section?

What is the main argument in this section?

What kind of examples or comparisons are being made in the passage?

Has this subject been brought up previously in the book? If so, how does that passage help us understand our current passage?

How is this passage asking us to change? Be specific.

What prevents us from changing?

What steps need to be taken to address this issue?

How can I turn to God for help in applying these verses to my life?

If we do change, what are the consequences of living in faith and obedience? What is the cost and what is better?
